WOF = width of fabric

45440 J – Merlin's Dragons Panel

- Fussy cut the center dragon scene panel
21 1/2" wide x 22 1/4" high
- Fussy cut (6) wizard panels 6 1/4" wide x 7 1/8" high
- Fussy cut (2) long wizards panels
21 1/2" wide x 9 1/2" high

45441 K – Dragon Print

- Cut (1) strip 14 1/2" x WOF; recut into
(4) 9 1/2" x 14 1/2" rectangles for third border
- Cut (1) strip 9 1/2" x WOF; recut into
(4) 8" x 9 1/2" rectangles for third border

45443 B – Aqua Print

- Cut (1) strip 7" x WOF; recut into (4) 7" squares
for first border corners

45444 HB – Stripe

- Cut (2) strips 2 7/8" x WOF; recut into
(8) 2 7/8" x 7" rectangles for first border

45445 N – Navy Stars

- Cut (2) strips 2 7/8" x WOF; recut into (8)
2 7/8" x 7" rectangles for first border

45447 B – Aqua

- Cut (2) strips 2 7/8" x WOF; recut into (8)
2 7/8" x 7" rectangles for first border

45447 H – Green

- Cut (2) strips 2 7/8" x WOF; recut into (8)
2 7/8" x 7" rectangles for first border

45445 V – Purple Stars

- Cut (1) strip 3 1/2" x WOF; recut into (2) 3 1/2" x 7"
rectangles and (2) 2 1/2" x 7" rectangles for
first border

- Cut (2) strips 1 1/2" x 35 1/2" and (2) strips
1 1/2" x 36 1/2" for second border

- Cut (3) strips 2 1/8" x WOF; recut into
(12) 2 1/8" x 7 1/8" strips

- Cut (3) strips 1 3/4" x WOF; recut into
(12) 1 3/4" x 9 1/2" strips

- Cut (6) strips 2 1/2" x WOF for binding

45442 J - Wizards -backing

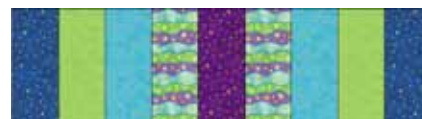
Cut 2 pieces 62" by WOF. Sew together along
selvage using 1" seam allowance. Trim seam
allowance to 1/2" and press open.

Instructions:

Note: Refer to the quilt photo for positioning of
pieces throughout the following steps.

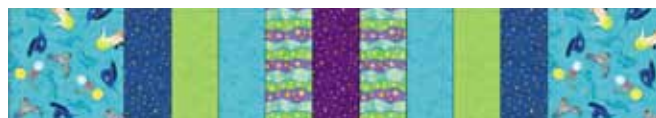
1. Assemble (2) navy star, (2) green, (2) aqua, and
(2) stripe 2 7/8" x 7" rectangles with (1) purple star
3 1/2" x 7" rectangle to make a side border strip.
Press seams in one direction. Repeat to make a
second side border strip.

Side Border Strip Make 2



2. Assemble (2) navy star, (2) green, (2) aqua, and
(2) stripe 2 7/8" x 7" rectangles with (1) purple star
2 1/2" x 7" rectangle to make a strip. Press seams in
one direction. Sew an aqua print 7" square to each
end to complete the top border strip. Press seams
away from the squares. Repeat to make the bottom
border strip.

Top/Bottom Border Strip Make 2



3. Sew the side border strips to the sides of the
center panel and the top/bottom border strips to
the top and bottom. Press seams toward the border
strips.

4. Sew the purple star 1 1/2" x 35 1/2" strips to the
sides of the bordered center panel and the
1 1/2" x 36 1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Press
seams toward the strips.

5. Sew a purple star 2 1/8" x 7 1/8" strip to the long
sides of each 6 1/4" x 7 1/8" wizard rectangle and a
purple star 1 3/4" x 9 1/2" strip to the top and bottom.
Trim each framed unit to 9 1/2" square to make (6)
Wizard blocks. Press seams toward the strips.

6. Sew a dragon print $9\frac{1}{2}''$ x $14\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle to the top and bottom of (2) Wizard blocks to make (2) side strips, referring to the quilt photo for placement of the Wizard blocks. Press seams toward the dragon print rectangles.

Top/Bottom Border Strip Make 2



8. Sew the side strips to the sides of the quilt center and the top and bottom strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top. Press seams toward the strips.

9. Layer, quilt and bind, as desired, to complete the quilt.

Side Border Strip Make 2



7. Sew a dragon print $8''$ x $9\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle to each end of the $21\frac{1}{2}''$ x $9\frac{1}{2}''$ wizard panels. Press seams toward the dragon rectangles. Sew a Wizard block to each end of the pieced strips to complete the top and bottom border strips. Press seams toward the dragon rectangles.
